

# Matthew Henry Ball



Matthew was born in St George's London in 1880 and soon after the family moved to Isleworth. He enlisted in Hounslow into the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry, 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion (6694). In the 1891 census, Matthew (aged 10) is living at 8 Queen's Terrace, Worple Road in Isleworth with his father James, mother Jane, younger sister Florence and younger brother Alfred. The family name is listed as Balls. In 1901, Matthew is listed as living at 6 Stuarts Place in Twickenham.

In the 1911 census, Matthew is a trenchman for the Metropolitan Water Board, living at 4 Algar Road, Isleworth with his father, James, aged 63, a jobbing gardener and a widower.

In June 1912, Matthew married Elsie Elizabeth Gertrude Sims and they lived together at 42 North Street, Isleworth and they had a daughter, Edith Elsie born on 8<sup>th</sup> April, 1912.

In the 1915 electoral register, Matthew is shown as having been resident at 2 Watson's Cottages, Sutton and 28 North Street, Isleworth. He was commemorated at the Isleworth Mission Church along with his mother-

in-law, Isabella. Matthew died from wounds on 15<sup>th</sup> November, 1914, aged 34 and is buried in Le Touquet – Paris Plage Communal Cemetery, grave ref. 1. A. 4. He was awarded the Victory and 1914 Star medals and is listed on his grave as “a native of Isleworth”.
