

## George Henry Albert Price



George was born on 27th November, 1889 to Thomas William Price, a bricklayer from Richmond and Mary Jane Mitchell of Harlington, Middlesex. He was baptised on 23rd February, 1890 in St Mary Magdalene Church in Richmond. In the 1891 census, the family are listed as living at 2 Crofton Terrace in Richmond. George has an elder sister, Annie Amelia who was born in Brentford in 1873, a brother William Thomas who was born in Richmond in 1885 and a sister Elizabeth Maud born in Richmond in 1887. The 1901 census records the family still living at 2 Crofton Terrace but they have the addition of Rosetta Mary born in 1893. William is now working as a grocer's errand boy.

According to the 1911 census, the family has moved to 16 Haliburton Road in St Margaret's (*see below left for a photograph taken in 2016 and a map of the Haliburton Road area in 1915*) and Thomas, now 61, is out of work. William has become a bricklayer and George is a plumber's mate. Rose is working as a housemaid for a distiller, John Archer, and living at Devonshire Lodge in Richmond. Interestingly, Rosetta Mary lived until April 1987 and died aged 94 having never married.



George enlisted in Ealing into the 1st/8th Battalions of the Duke of Cambridge's Own (Middlesex) Regiment as Private T/5377. He was sent home on 18th March, 1916 and died at home of nephritis (inflammation of the kidneys) on 19th March, 1916 aged 26. He is buried in Isleworth Cemetery grave ref. T. B. 19 (*see above right*). George is also remembered on the memorial at All Souls Church, Northcote Road, Isleworth.
